Putting Christ First in 2020 Matthew 2:1-12 December 29, 2019

Today we'll learn lessons from the wise men that will help us to put Christ first in the coming year!

- 1. Put Christ First Every Day (Matthew 2:1-2, 10).
 - a. Seeking the Messiah was the top priority of the wise men.
 - i. They were students of the Scriptures.
 - 1. It is very possible that the magi were aware of Balaam's prophecy in Numbers 24:17.
 - 2. If they were aware of Daniel's prophecy of 70 weeks, they could have very likely been counting down the years and scanning the heavens for the star.
 - ii. They took an amazing step of faith according to the Scriptures.
 - 1. They likely traveled over 900 miles from Persia at great cost and risk.
 - 2. They were intent upon seeking and worshipping Christ no matter what the cost.
 - b. Application: Each of us should follow the example of the Magi by seeking God as our top priority every day.
 - i. Psalm 63:1 "O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;"
 - ii. Mark 1:35 "And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed."
 - iii. Make prayer and Bible reading the first thing you do every day!
 - iv. Act upon what you read!
- 2. Put Christ First Every Week (Matthew 2:2, 9-10).
 - a. Worshipping Christ was the main goal of the wise men (2).
 - i. Worship is treasuring Christ.
 - ii. Worshipping Christ valuing Christ above all else.
 - iii. When the wise men saw the star they rejoiced with an overabundance of joy (9-10).
 - iv. Worship is not just an action; worship is from the heart.
 - b. Application: Each of us should follow the example of the Magi by setting aside the first day of every week to worship God!
 - i. Acts 20:7 "And upon the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached unto them..."
 - ii. Hebrews 10:25 "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching."
 - iii. Set aside the first day of the week for corporate worship!
 - iv. What you do first sets the tone for the rest of the week!
- 3. Put Christ First Every Month (Matthew 2:11-12).
 - a. Giving tangible gifts to God was the culmination of the wise men's worship.
 - i. The wise men chose gifts that were of great value in that day.
 - ii. The wise men's gifts likely financed Joseph and Mary's flight into Egypt.
 - 1. God uses the gifts of His people to further the ministry of the Gospel.
 - 2. When God's people give, the work of God flourishes.
 - 3. When God's people withhold their treasures, God's work is jeopardized.
 - b. Application: Each of us should follow the example of the Magi by offering the firstfruits of our treasure to the Savior.
 - i. Leviticus 27:30 "And all the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land, or of the fruit of the tree, is the LORD's: it is holy unto the LORD."
 - ii. Some would say, "If I were to start tithing, I'd have to reorder my entire life." And that is precisely the point of tithing, ordering our lives around God's priorities.
 - iii. Matthew 6:33 "But seek ye first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you."
